

**ORAS QA: Standard Form Scoring-CST**

There are 40 critical questions which missed can cause significant problems in assessing the offender and making appropriate referrals. These questions will receive a weight of 2.0. In addition, 8 additional questions will also be rated but these are more geared toward record keeping and neatness and therefore receive a weight of 1. The total score on the ORAS QA instrument is calculated as follows:

Caseworkers can be rated as being Proficient, Acceptable, or Unacceptable using the QA instrument. Below are the cutoffs for each category. For illustrative purposes, a caseworker can miss up to two critical questions and still receive a *Proficient* score, and up to five critical questions to receive an *Acceptable* score.

**ORAS QA: Short Form Scoring- CSST**

The same logic applies to the short form and has been calculated below. Because of the brevity of this form a caseworker cannot miss one critical question to be rated either *Proficient* or *Acceptable*.

**ORAS QA: Standard Form Scoring- SRT**

There are 36 critical questions which missed can cause significant problems in assessing the offender and making appropriate referrals. These questions will receive a weight of 2.0. In addition, 8 additional questions will also be rated but these are more geared toward record keeping and neatness and therefore receive a weight of 1. The total score on the ORAS QA instrument is calculated as follows:

Non-Critical	8	1.0	8.0	10

Caseworkers can be rated as being Proficient, Acceptable, or Unacceptable using the QA instrument. Below are the cutoffs for each category. For illustrative purposes, a caseworker can miss up to two critical questions and still receive a *Proficient* score, and up to five critical questions to receive an *Acceptable* score.
